The funding would be used to construct a second well, with a well house, and connect it to existing water mains. The City of Peterson is currently noncompliant with the Minnesota Department of Health, who requires two wells.

With no other water source available, if the well were to fail the entire town would be without water, which would severely impact the residents of Peterson as well as the city's ability to perform fire response in the area.

The project has a Federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized by Section 1452 of the Safe Drinking Water Act, 42 U.S.C. 300j-12.
